Zero Register is a system that requires the press to be timed throughout the entire press run.

The purpose of timing the printing press is to introduce the corrugated sheets into the printing press by use of a kicker system or a cam style lead edge feeder precisely, so the printing is registered to the die cut and registered to the sheet.

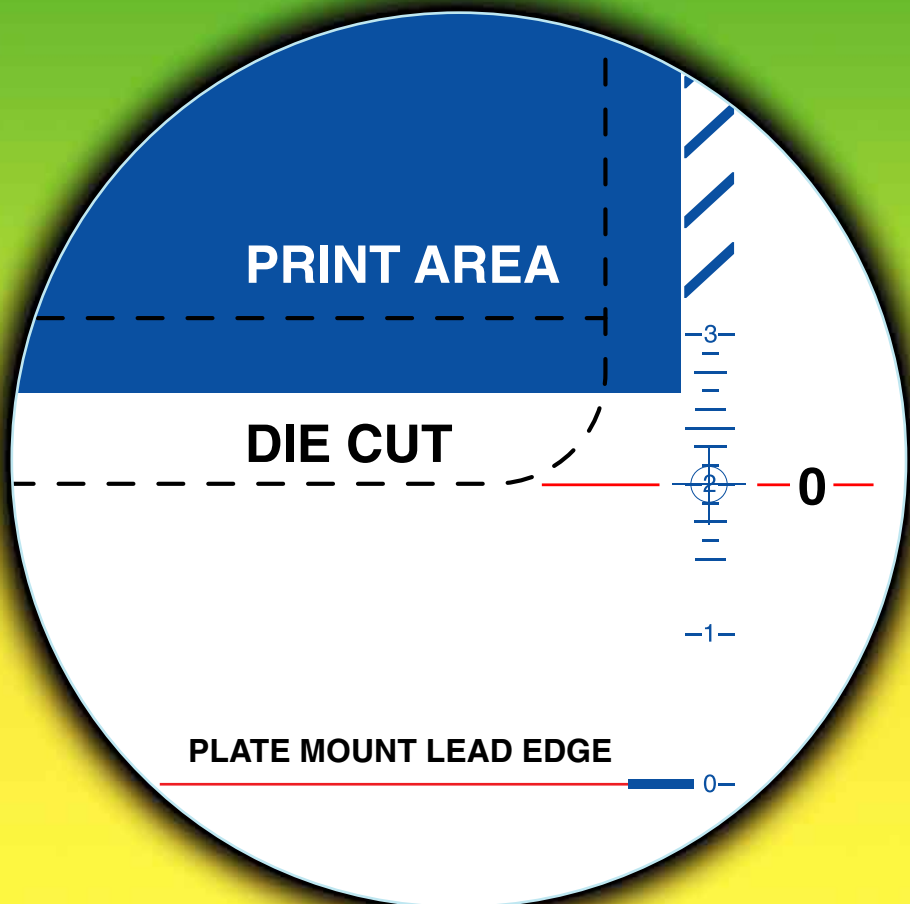
Zero Registered Plates
